# Lesson 2

## Moses Escapes to Midian

Read Exodus 2:11–25 (New International Reader's Version)



In Acts 7:23, we learn that Moses was 40 years old when these events took place.

- 1 What did Moses do one day when he had grown up? One day, when Moses was 40 years old, he went out to where his \_\_\_\_\_ people were and \_\_\_\_\_ them while they were \_\_\_\_\_ at work. (Ex. 2:11)
- 2 What did Moses see? He saw an Egyptian \_\_\_\_\_ a \_\_\_\_\_ man. (Ex. 2:11)

- 6 What was the man's response to Moses' question? The man asked Moses, "Who made you ruler and \_\_\_\_\_ over us? Are you thinking about \_\_\_\_\_ me as you killed the Egyptian?" (Ex. 2:14)



Uh-oh! It looks like either Moses missed seeing someone the other day when he had looked around to make sure no one was watching, or else the man he had rescued had gone and blabbed about it to everyone!

- 7 What was Moses' reaction when he found out people must have heard about him killing an Egyptian to save a Hebrew? Moses became \_\_\_\_\_. (Ex. 2:14)
- 8 What was Pharaoh's reaction when he found out Moses had killed an Egyptian to save a Hebrew? Pharaoh tried to \_\_\_\_\_ Moses. (Ex. 2:15)
- 9 Was Moses able to escape Pharaoh? (Yes/No) \_\_\_\_\_. (Ex. 2:15)
- 10 Where did Moses go to live? Moses went to live in \_\_\_\_\_. (Ex. 2:15)
- 11 When Moses arrived in Midian, where did he sit down? Moses sat down by a \_\_\_\_\_. (Ex. 2:15)
- 12 While Moses was sitting, who came by to fill their stone tubs with water to feed their father's flock? \_\_\_\_\_ daughters of a \_\_\_\_\_ of Midian came by. (Ex. 2:16)
- 13 What did some shepherds do? Some shepherds came along and \_\_\_\_\_ the girls away. (Ex. 2:17)
- 14 What did Moses do about this? Moses got up, \_\_\_\_\_ the seven sisters, and then gave \_\_\_\_\_ to their flock. (Ex. 2:17)



I wonder what happened to the shepherds who bullied the girls?

- 15) What was the response of Reuel (the father of the seven girls) when his daughters told him why they had returned home so early that day? Reuel asked \_\_\_\_\_ the man was who had helped them and \_\_\_\_\_ they had left him at the well. (Ex. 2:20)
- 16) What did Reuel tell his daughters to do? He told them to \_\_\_\_\_ Moses to have something to \_\_\_\_\_ with them. (Ex. 2:20)
- 17) What did this meal lead to? This meal led to Moses \_\_\_\_\_ with Reuel and his family, and to Reuel \_\_\_\_\_ his daughter Zipporah to Moses to be his \_\_\_\_\_. (Ex. 2:21)

- 19) Who finally died after a long time? The \_\_\_\_\_ of Egypt died. (Ex. 2:23)

- 21) Who heard the Israelites’ groans and cries for help? \_\_\_\_\_ heard their groans and cries for help and had \_\_\_\_\_ for them. (Ex. 2:24–25)

- 22) Does God hear your cries for help and have concern for you too? (Yes/No) \_\_\_\_\_.
