## **Jacob Marries Leah and Rachel**

#### Genesis 29:14b-30

<sup>14b</sup>Jacob stayed with Laban for a whole month. <sup>15</sup>Then Laban said to him, "You are one of my relatives. But is that any reason for you to work for me for nothing? Tell me what your pay should be."

<sup>16</sup>Laban had two daughters. The name of the older one was Leah. And the name of the younger one was Rachel. <sup>17</sup>Leah was plain, but Rachel was beautiful. She had a nice figure. <sup>18</sup>Jacob was in love with Rachel. He said to Laban, "I'll work for you for seven years so I can marry your younger daughter Rachel."

<sup>19</sup>Laban said, "It's better for me to give her to you than to some other man. Stay here with me." <sup>20</sup>So Jacob worked for seven years so he could marry Rachel. But they seemed like only a few days to him because he loved her so much.

<sup>21</sup>Then Jacob said to Laban, "Give me my wife. I've completed my time. I want to sleep with her."

<sup>22</sup>So Laban brought all the people of the place together and had a feast prepared. <sup>23</sup>But when evening came, he gave his daughter Leah to Jacob. And Jacob slept with her. <sup>24</sup>Laban gave his female servant Zilpah to his daughter as her servant.

<sup>25</sup>When Jacob woke up the next morning, there was Leah next to him! So he said to Laban, "What have you done to me? I worked for you so I could marry Rachel, didn't I? Why did you trick me?"

<sup>26</sup>Laban replied, "It isn't our practice here to give the younger daughter to be married before the older one. <sup>27</sup>Complete this daughter's wedding week. Then we'll give you the younger one also. But you will have to work for another seven years."

<sup>28</sup>So Jacob completed the week with Leah. Then Laban gave him his daughter Rachel to be his wife. <sup>29</sup>Laban gave his female servant Bilhah to his daughter Rachel as her servant. <sup>30</sup>Jacob slept with Rachel also. He loved Rachel more than he loved Leah. And he worked for Laban for another seven years.

# **Jacob Becomes the Father of Many Children**

#### Genesis 29:31-35

<sup>31</sup>The Lord saw that Jacob didn't love Leah as much as he loved Rachel. So He let Leah have children. But Rachel wasn't able to have children. <sup>32</sup>Leah became pregnant. She had a son. She named him Reuben. She said, "The Lord has seen me suffer. Surely my husband will love me now."

<sup>33</sup>She became pregnant again. She had a son. Then she said, "The Lord heard that Jacob doesn't love me very much. That's why the Lord gave me this one too." So she named him Simeon.

<sup>34</sup>She became pregnant again. She had a son. Then she said, "Now at last my husband will value me. I have had three sons by him." So the boy was named Levi.

<sup>35</sup>She became pregnant again. She had a son. Then she said, "This time I'll praise the Lord." So she named him Judah. Then she stopped having children.

Special note: The first part of the next chapter in Genesis, Chapter 30, is about how Jacob's next eight children were born. It is a sad account of the jealousy and fights between the two sisters Leah and Rachel.

When Rachel saw that she wasn't having children, she became upset and gave her servant Bilhah to Jacob as a wife so Bilhah could have children for Rachel. Bilhah had two sons by Jacob, and Rachel named them Dan and Naphtali. During this time, Leah stopped having children, so she gave her servant Zilpah to Jacob as a wife. Zilpah also had two sons by Jacob, and Leah named them Gad and Asher. However, later Leah was able to have two more sons and a daughter by Jacob. Leah named these two sons Issachar and Zebulun and named her daughter Dinah. God then showed concern for Rachel and made it possible for her to have children: Rachel had a son by Jacob and named him Joseph.

Leah and Rachel's hostile relationship produced a toxic environment for their children. God says in Genesis 2:24, "A man leaves his father and mother and is joined to his wife. The two of them become one flesh." Man was created by God to have only one wife.
