

# Lesson 22

## Psalm 91:1–16 (writer unknown)

- <sup>1</sup>Whoever rests in the shadow of the Most High God  
will be kept safe by the Mighty One.
- <sup>2</sup>I will say about the Lord,  
“He is my place of safety.  
He is like a fort to me.  
He is my God. I trust in Him.”
- <sup>3</sup>He will certainly save you from hidden traps  
and from deadly sickness.
- <sup>4</sup>He will cover you with His wings.  
Under the feathers of His wings you will find safety.  
He is faithful. He will keep you safe like a shield or a tower.
- <sup>5</sup>You won't have to be afraid of the terrors that come during the night.  
You won't have to fear the arrows that come at you during the day.
- <sup>6</sup>You won't have to be afraid of the sickness that attacks in the darkness.  
You won't have to fear the plague that destroys at noon.
- <sup>7</sup>A thousand may fall dead at your side.  
Ten thousand may fall near your right hand.  
But no harm will come to you.
- <sup>8</sup>You will see with your own eyes  
how God punishes sinful people.
- <sup>9</sup>Suppose you say, “The Lord is the One who keeps me safe.”  
Suppose you let the Most High God be like a home to you.
- <sup>10</sup>Then no harm will come to you.  
No terrible plague will come near your tent.
- <sup>11</sup>The Lord will command His angels  
to take good care of you.
- <sup>12</sup>They will lift you up in their hands.  
Then you won't trip over a stone.
- <sup>13</sup>You will walk on lions and cobras.  
You will crush mighty lions and poisonous snakes.
- <sup>14</sup>The Lord says, “I will save the one who loves Me.

I will keep him safe, because he trusts in Me.

<sup>15</sup>He will call out to Me, and I will answer him.

I will be with him in times of trouble.

I will save him and honour him.

<sup>16</sup>I will give him a long and full life.

I will save him.”

<sup>5</sup>Lord, how great are the things You do!

How wise Your thoughts are!

<sup>6</sup>Here is something that people without sense don't know.

Here is what foolish people don't understand.

<sup>7</sup>Those who are evil spring up like grass.

Those who do wrong succeed.

But they will be destroyed forever.

<sup>8</sup>But Lord, You are honoured forever.

...

<sup>12</sup>Those who do what is right will grow like a palm tree.

They will grow strong like a cedar tree in Lebanon.

<sup>13</sup>Their roots will be firm in the house of the Lord.

They will grow strong and healthy in the courtyards of our God.

<sup>14</sup>When they get old, they will still bear fruit.

Like young trees they will stay fresh and strong.

<sup>15</sup>They will say to everyone, "The Lord is honest.

He is my Rock, and there is no evil in Him."

<sup>4</sup>But Lord, You are more powerful than the roar of the ocean.  
You are stronger than the waves of the sea.  
Lord, You are powerful in heaven.

<sup>5</sup>Your laws do not change, Lord.  
Your temple will be holy  
for all time to come.
