

# Lesson 26

## Psalm 105:1–5 (writer unknown)

- <sup>1</sup>Give praise to the Lord and announce who He is.  
Tell the nations what He has done.
- <sup>2</sup>Sing to Him, sing praise to Him.  
Tell about all the wonderful things He has done.
- <sup>3</sup>Praise Him, because His Name is holy.  
Let the hearts of those who trust in the Lord be glad.
- <sup>4</sup>Seek the Lord and the strength He gives.  
Always seek Him.
- <sup>5</sup>Remember the wonderful things He has done.  
Remember His miracles and how He judged our enemies.

## Questions

Who can praise Him as much as He should be praised?
- <sup>3</sup>Blessed are those who always do what is fair.  
Blessed are those who keep doing what is right.

**Psalm 108:1–5, 13 (written by David)**

<sup>1</sup>God, my heart feels secure.

<sup>2</sup>Harp and lyre, wake up!

<sup>3</sup>Lord, I will praise You among the nations.

I will sing about You among the people of the earth.

<sup>4</sup>Great is Your love. It is higher than the heavens.

Your truth reaches to the skies.

<sup>5</sup>God, may You be honoured above the heavens.

Let Your glory be over the whole earth.

...

<sup>13</sup>With Your help we will win the battle.

You will walk all over our enemies.

## Psalm 109:1–5, 21–31 (written by David)

<sup>1</sup>God, I praise You.

Don't remain silent.

<sup>2</sup>Sinful people who lie and cheat have spoken against me.

They have used their tongues to tell lies about me.

<sup>3</sup>They gather all around me with their words of hatred.

They attack me without any reason.

<sup>4</sup>They bring charges against me,

even though I love them

and pray for them.

<sup>5</sup>They pay me back with evil for the good things I do.

They pay back my love with hatred.

...

<sup>21</sup>But Lord and King,

help me so that You bring honour to Yourself.

Because Your love is so good, save me.

<sup>22</sup>I am poor and needy.

My heart is wounded deep down inside me.

<sup>23</sup>I fade away like an evening shadow.

I'm like a locust that someone brushes off.

<sup>24</sup>My knees are weak because I've gone without food.

My body is very thin.

<sup>25</sup>Those who bring charges against me laugh at me.

When they see me, they shake their heads at me.

<sup>26</sup>Lord my God, help me.

Save me because of Your faithful love.

<sup>27</sup>Lord, let my enemies know that You Yourself have saved me.

You have done it with Your own hand.

<sup>28</sup>They may curse me.

But may You bless me.

May those who attack me be put to shame.

But may I be filled with joy.

<sup>29</sup>May those who bring charges against me be clothed with dishonour.

May they be wrapped in shame as if it were a coat.

<sup>30</sup>With my mouth I will continually praise the Lord.

I will praise Him when all His people gather for worship.

<sup>31</sup>He stands ready to help those who need it.

He saves them from those who are ready to sentence them to death.

## Psalm 111:1–4, 7–10 (writer unknown)

<sup>1</sup>Praise the Lord.

I will praise the Lord with all my heart.

I will praise Him where honest people gather for worship.

<sup>2</sup>The Lord has done great things.

All who take delight in those things think deeply about them.

<sup>3</sup>What He does shows His glory and majesty.

He will always do what is right.

<sup>4</sup>The Lord causes His wonders to be remembered.

He is kind and tender.

...

<sup>7</sup>He is faithful and right in everything He does.

All His rules can be trusted.

<sup>8</sup>They will stand firm for ever and ever.

They were given by the Lord.

He is faithful and honest.

<sup>9</sup>He set His people free.

He made a covenant with them that will last forever.

His Name is holy and wonderful.

<sup>10</sup>If you really want to become wise,

you must begin by having respect for the Lord.

All those who follow His rules have good understanding.

People should praise Him forever.
